Observation to the area damaged by the Great East Japan Earthquake and by the subsequent accident of Fukushima No.1 Nuclear Power Plant. At **Tomioka Town**, you will attend a tour guided by the 'Kataribe', who tells about the experience of the earthquake and the history of their continuous efforts toward recovery.

You will also visit the **commercial community facilities, Hamakaze kirara**, which opened in 2017 spring. It will bring you the discoveries and experiences how they operate their stores by having lunch there. The shops had been operating more than five years at the temporary shopping mall since soon after the earthquake.
