

# Edo-Taste Old Town Tour with Young Civil Engineers

- Time slip trip back to the Edo period -

Place to Visit: - **historical buildings in Kawagoe** -

Kawagoe played an important role in politics and military in the Edo period as it offered northern protection for Edo Castle. Today people can enjoy the vestiges of this era still visible in Kawagoe's elegant streets, old-time sweets shops and the town bell that sounds the hour. Stroll the streets of Koedo (Little Edo) and enjoy a time slip trip back to the Edo period.

This tour will guide you to five historical buildings. First, we will visit "**Osawa house**", built in 1792. This house is the oldest of existing Kurazukuri daubed houses in the Kanto region. Second, "**The Time Bell Tower**", that is the clock tower of height 16m, and symbol of Kawagoe. Third, "**Saitama Resona Bank**", that is the country registration tangible cultural property, built in 1918. And then, "**Kawagoe chamber of commerce**", that is the nationally designated tangible cultural property, built in 1928. Finally, "**The Renkei Temple**" that is the historical temple built in the Muromachi period. This temple worship "Obinzuru-sama" which may be cure the disease if you touch that.
