**Tokyo Metropolitan Government Buildings** 

Shinjuku subcenter has been developed by Tokyo Metropolitan Government under the Metropolitan Area Readjustment Act proclaimed in 1956. Since then, Shinjuku has been identified as a city of "business and interaction". As a part of this project, **Tokyo Metropolitan Government (TMG) Buildings** was moved into this area in 1991. TMG Buildings has two high-rise skyscraper buildings (48 floors totaling 243 meters height) covering 382,000 square meters of total floor area with high-tech features.

This tour will take you to explore Shinjuku subcenter, which has many skyscrapers as one of most developed business districts in Japan. After you see this area from the ground level, you will go up to the observation deck on the top floor of Tokyo Metropolitan Government (TMG) Buildings. You will enjoy a high-speed elevator, which takes only 55 seconds to go to the 45th floor. There you can enjoy commanding views of downtown Tokyo from a height of 202 meters!
